



## SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENT APPLICATION ENQUIRY 2020

Thank you for your expression of interest in Quinns Baptist College. The College is an independent, co-educational college from Pre-Kindy to Year 12, governed by a Board consisting of representatives from Quinns Baptist College Association. Affiliation with a church is not a pre-requisite for entry; however, it is a requirement that students and parents accept that teachers have the right to interpret and present knowledge from a Christian perspective.

Please find enclosed a Registration of Interest form, which is required to be completed and returned in order to have your child placed on the waitlist. Please note that existing Quinns Baptist College Primary School students are automatically offered places in the Secondary School and are not required to pay an additional registration or confirmation fee.

Quinns Baptist College's philosophy is that all possible costs incurred by the College in educating our students are incorporated into the tuition fees. We endeavour to uphold our philosophy so that parents are well-informed and may budget accordingly. It is also the aim to provide students a quality education at an affordable price.

Whilst not all children choose to utilise the opportunities provided at the College, they can still benefit from the positive ethos of their learning environment. QBC's caring and dedicated staff and effective student management system underpin a safe, nurturing and balanced environment that encourages students to develop academically, emotionally and spiritually.

Enrolment costs include a registration fee of **\$100** per family, which is non-refundable and must accompany the registration form. A confirmation fee, which is a non-refundable **\$400** deposit per enrolment, is deducted from the first account of annual fees. Confirmation of enrolment is also dependent on prospective parents and students attending an interview with the Secondary Principal.

### FEES 2020

The annual tuition fee for Secondary students is **\$2,976** per student. Please note there is no sibling discount for families and the compulsory Year 9 and Year 11 camps incur an additional fee of approximately \$400. Other costs associated with uniforms and text books should also be anticipated.

For your information, the annual tuition fees include:

- The confirmation fee of \$400 is deducted off the initial annual fee
- All subject fees are inclusive, including Cert Courses and specialist courses, eg Outdoor Ed, Tourism, Fitness, Music Production, Languages, Art, Woodwork, Foods
- All excursions/incursions and co-curricular events, such as the Busselton Endurance Weekend; the Port to Pub Swim; the South West Netball Tour; the Bibbulmun Hike and Leadership activities
- All costs for transport to carnivals, excursions, classes off-campus, camps, etc. are provided.
- After-school tutoring for core subjects e.g. Maths, English, Science, HASS and upper school courses
- All photocopying resources
- All technology (personal devices are issued for student use in classes)
- Complimentary copy (per family) of the Quinns Baptist College Year Book
- A range of music band programs
- All co-curricular/sports programs including team uniforms, tournament entry fees and specialist coaching
- Graduation costs waived for Year 12 students and their parents
- No requirement for parent hours or payment in lieu

Please be advised that extra costs apply for the following:

- Compulsory Year 9 and Year 11 camps (approximately \$400 per camp)
- Optional events, such as the Euro Tour; Malaysian Tour, Mauritius/Reunion Tour, the Bali Compassion Tour, and year level social events (approximately \$20 per term)
