



UNIFORM POLICY (SECONDARY)

Scope

This policy provides guidance on the uniform required to be worn by students in the Secondary School. Students will be issued with an infringement for not adhering to uniform requirements.

The uniform is to be worn all year round with acceptable variations for weather changes. The Secondary College has a Formal Uniform and Sports Uniform.

The College has a Uniform Shop on site where all uniform items are to be purchased.

Formal Uniform

The Formal Uniform is to be worn on days where no physically-based lessons are timetabled for the student.

The formal uniform must be worn neat and tidy at all times including on the way to and from school or when in public.

Boys must tuck their shirts in at all times.
Socks must be worn above the ankle.

Only approved uniform items may be worn when in school uniform.

Students should be well groomed at all times, i.e: clean shaven, hair neat and tidy.



Sports Uniform

Students are to wear the Sports Uniform for the full day when they have the following classes timetabled:

- Physical Education
- Fitness
- Phys Ed Studies (double lesson only)
- Dance
- Outdoor Education
- Outdoor Recreation VET (double lesson only)
- Sport and Recreation VET
- Rugby Union

At times, classroom teachers may prefer students to wear their Sports Uniform for practical activities. This should be communicated to parents by the classroom teacher prior to the designated lesson through SMS.

Achievement Badges

Senior students awarded with achievement badges should hand stitch them on to the left breast of their College jackets.

Leavers Jackets

Year 12 students may wear their Leavers Jacket instead of the College Jacket.

School Bags

The College bag is **compulsory**. Bags must be kept in good condition and not covered in graffiti. Unsatisfactory bags will need to be replaced. Students will not be permitted to use other non-College bags, unless it is a requirement that extra items be brought to school for the day.

Jewellery

- Only a plain watch is permitted (smart watches are not permitted as per SCSA guidelines).
- Only one pair of plain earrings are permitted in the lower ear lobes.
- Additional piercings are not permitted under any circumstances.
- No other jewellery is permitted.

Tattoos

Tattoos of any kind are not permitted to be visible when in uniform (including Henna tattoos). Tattoos must be covered up at all times.

Grooming

- Coloured nail polish is not permitted. Make-up must be natural looking and not excessive.
- Boys must be clean shaven. Facial hair (beards or moustaches) are not permitted.

Hair

- Conventional hair styles only are permitted. Students will be required to modify any hairstyle deemed unconventional.
- Hair longer than the collar must be completely tied up at all times.
- Hair is to be kept from falling in front of the eyes.
- Natural hair colours only are permitted.

Accessories

- Hair accessories should be plain and not decorative.
- Gloves must be plain black and not fingerless gloves.
- Students are permitted to wear the College scarf and beanie only.
- Sunglasses are permitted to be worn outdoors only.
- College hats must be worn when in the sun for all outdoor class activities and during breaks.

Non-uniform clothing

Clothing that is not an approved Uniform item is not permitted to be worn with the College Uniform e.g: Sports Jumpers, hoodies, jackets, etc.

Co-Curricular Inter-school Sports

Students involved in the co-curricular sports must wear the designated uniform for that sport. Tops/dresses will be provided by the College.

The College shorts must be worn for all sports requiring shorts.

The College Jacket or College Rugby Jumper is the only jumper permitted to be worn to and from sporting events.

House Days

Sports uniform must be worn on House Days with the College House shirt instead of the College Sport shirt (see the calendar for specified days).
