



UNIFORM POLICY

Quinns Baptist College has established a uniform dress code which states that all students who attend the College will be required to wear College uniform. This contributes to the following:

- the fostering and enhancement of the public image of the College
- improving morale, team spirit and pride in the College
- ensuring that students are safely dressed for College activities
- encouraging equality among students, reducing rivalry
- identifying non-College students on campus

All students are required to wear the College uniform in a manner which is a credit to the student and the College. High standards of personal grooming are expected to be maintained by College students including travelling to and from the College.

In addition to wearing appropriate items of clothing and conforming to all of the requirements for make-up, hair and grooming, students are expected to keep their uniform in good condition and wear it properly. All students should comply with the following:

- the shirt should be tucked in fully and not rolled up
- the top button of the shirt must be done up at all times when wearing a tie
- the tie should be neatly tied and pulled up so that it covers the top button
- the tie should be a reasonable length (just above the waist)
- shoes should be clean and polished
- shorts should be worn neatly with the hem **just** above the knee
- trousers should be worn neatly with the belt above the hip
- in all cases, socks must completely cover the ankle
- The College skirt must be worn no shorter than just above the knee (2 – 4 cm)
- College shirts must be tucked in at all times so that the waistband can be seen.
- Formal uniform items are not permitted to be worn with Sports Uniform or vice versa.

BAGS

The College bag/back pack is **compulsory**. Bags must be kept in good condition and not covered in graffiti. Unsatisfactory bags will need to be replaced. Students will not be permitted to use other non-College bags unless it is a requirement that extra items be brought to school for the day.

SEASON CHANGEOVER

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4 and the winter uniform is worn during Terms 2 and 3. **Yr 12's will remain in winter uniform for Term 4.**

HAIR STANDARDS

At all times when the student is in school uniform hair must appear tidy and well cared for. All hair must be kept short or tied back neatly with elastics or a Scrunchy. Hair accessories must be in the school colours and **must not be excessively decorative**. Collar length hair must be either cut or tied up off the face and must not fall past the eyebrows. Inappropriate hairstyles or unnatural hair colour may require modification at the Principal's discretion. Students will be required to remain at home until their hair returns to normal. Haircuts must be **no shorter than #2**.

HATS

As part of the school duty of care and serious increase in skin cancer, students are required to wear a school hat for all outdoor activities during **Term 1** and **Term 4** (including recess and lunch breaks). If a student does not have a hat whilst in the sun they will receive an infringement. Hats during sport lessons are required all year round. Failure to bring a hat will have the following consequences:

- 1st offence – warning.
- 2nd offence – infringement.
- 3rd offence – send out.

JEWELLERY

No jewellery is allowed except for a plain watch (smart watches are not permitted) and a maximum of one pair of **plain** stud or sleeper earrings in the lower lobe of the ear(s). Necklaces, bracelets, anklets of any nature **are not permitted**.

PIERCINGS AND TATTOOS

Visible body piercing, other than the lower earlobe, and tattoos are not permitted.

Please note: Leniency will not be shown to students who choose to have extra visible piercing done during the school year. Use of a Band-Aid, plug or other covers for piercing and tattoos is not acceptable and will not be permitted. Students who choose to show piercings/ tattoos will be withdrawn from classes until the issue has been rectified. If in doubt, please check with your Year Coordinator beforehand.

MAKE-UP/ NAIL POLISH

Nail polish is not permitted. Make-up is only allowed if it is a subtle application of foundation and mascara only. Students may be requested to remove make-up if deemed excessive by a staff member. Refusal to do so will result in a send out.

CLEAN SHAVEN

All boys must be clean shaven during the school day and at all College events. Sideburns should not extend down past the earlobe. Students will be asked to shave at Teacher's discretion if unsuitable.

SHOES

High School students must wear black polished leather dress/ school shoes. Heels must be no higher than 20mm. Shoes must be properly tied at all times.

SPORTS UNIFORM

Sports uniforms are only to be worn on nominated sport or Physical Education days. Sports shoes must be **athletic trainers/joggers**. Basketball shoes, casual/ skate shoes, or canvas shoes of any nature are not permitted. Shoes must be properly tied at all times. Hats are compulsory during all PE lessons. If a hat is not brought for a third time to a PE lesson in one Term a send out will result.

SUNGLASSES

Students may wear sunglasses when outdoors but are not to wear them in class, or on their heads as decoration.

UNDERGARMENTS

Students are not permitted to wear bikini tops or coloured undergarments under their Uniform. Students' undergarments should not be visible at any time including tank tops, t-shirts, singlets or bands.
